MARY/EMPT EARLY PLACEMENT TEST

This test is comparable to mathematics placement tests given to incoming students in colleges and by some employers. You will be given feedback about how well you are progressing toward college-level mathematics.

Directions:

- 1. Choose the best answer (a through e) for each of the first 33 problems by using a number 2 pencil to mark your answer. Fill the selected answer block on the answer sheet darkly and completely. If you make a mistake, erase it as completely as possible.
- 2. Do not mark on this test booklet. Use scratch paper. Use only the front of the answer sheet.
- 3. Keep moving rather than spending too much time on any one problem. There is no penalty for guessing.
- 4. You may use a calculator (graphing or other kind) on this test. There is one problem (#33) especially for individuals with graphing calculators.
- 5. Concentrate on the first 33 problems. The last 12 problems are for students in calculus and pre-calculus who finish the earlier problems before the time limit.
